The Respondents resisted the claim of the Applicants contending that they were appointed purely on contractual basis and, therefore, they are not entitled to regularizations in Government service.</li> <li>4. Simultaneously, M.A. No.121/2018 is filed by the Respondents Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education raising objections on the point of jurisdiction contending that the Applicants are not holding any civil post and, therefore, the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain the O.A.</li> <li>5. The crux of the matter is whether the Applicants holding civil post and consequently falls within the jurisdiction of this Tribunal.</li> <li>6. On the request of learned Advocate for the Applicants, the matter is adjourned for hearing at the stage of admission.</li> <li>7.
