Earlier in O.A.No.83/2019 decided on 28.02.2019 and in O.A.No.328 &amp; 331/2019 decided on 08.07.2019 directions were issued to Respondents to relieve the Applicants therein and the same has been complied with.</li> <li>3. indeed, as per the order passed by this Tribunal in O.A.No.841/2015 decided on 29.01.2016 as well as on 237/2016 decided on 22.08.2016, Respondents are taken policy decision as reflected in Circular dated 16.07.2018 as well as 02.04.2018 to the effect that the deputation period should not exceed more than 5 years and on completion of 5 years, the Drivers should be sent back to their original establishment.</li> <li>4. It seems that despite this position, the Respondents are not repatriating the Drivers who have completed 5 years in Transport Department, and therefore, various Original Applications are being filed in the Tribunal for direction.</li> <li>5. Learned P.O. submits that for want of scarcity of Drivers, three months time is required to repatriate them.</li> <li>6. However, learned Counsel for the Applicant opposes to give three months time.</li> <li>7. In view of above, it would be appropriate to direct the Respondents to repatriate the Applicants within two months from today so that they should join their parent establishment.</li> <li>8.
