




ORDER

1. Heard Shri Arvind V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. In the present O.A., Applicant has challenged impugned transfer order dated 24.12.2019, whereby he has been transferred from the post of Sub Divisional Police Officer, Dhund, Pune (Rural) to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Protection of Civil Rights, Aurangabad.
3. During the course of hearing, learned P.O. for the Respondents has tendered file for the perusal of Tribunal and inspection was also taken by learned Advocate for the Applicant. As per the file, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has given approval to the transfer of the Applicant as competent authority.
4. However, learned Advocate for the Applicant has pointed out that as per Notification published in Gazette dated 12.12.2019, Home Minister is Shri Eknath Sambhaji Shinde. He has pointed out that the transfer order has been issued on 24.12.2019. He, therefore, submits that the Hon'ble Home Minister is the competent authority and not Hon'ble Chief Minister and therefore, the impugned transfer order is unsustainable in law.

5. The perusal of file reveals that it was sent to the Hon'ble Chief Minister's office on 29.11.2019. There is no date below signature of the Hon'ble Chief Minister. In such situation, it is necessary to find out who was the competent authority at the relevant time.
6. Learned P.O. for the Respondents, therefore, seeks time to file affidavit of Additional Chief Secretary to show the movement of file to find out on which date it was signed by Hon'ble Chief Minister. She has further pointed out that the applicant has been already relieved from the present post and Private respondent No.2 has already joined in place of the applicant.
7. In view of the above, I am not inclined to pass any interim relief at this stage. Affidavit be filed within one week.
