3. The perusal of the record reveals that the Respondent No.2 by his letter dated 03.12.2018 addressed to Respondent No.1 requested the Government to pass appropriate order about his absence period. Whereas Civil Surgeon, Pune has recommended to consider the said period as break in service as seen from contents of letter dated 03.12.2018. However, till date no decision has been taken by the Respondent No.2 and, therefore, the matter is stuck at the level of Respondent Nos.2 to 4.
