Heard Shri R.P. Bhumkar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri M.S. Mahajan, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. The Applicant has filed the Original Application with the request to quash and set aside the order dated 29.6.2019 by which he has been relieved from the post of Desk Officer from the office of State Information Commission, bench at Aurangabad by filing the Original Application.

3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant has submitted that the Applicant was deputed on the post of Desk Officer, State Information Commission, bench at Aurangabad for the period of 4 years by order dated 15.06.2015 and accordingly he joined the said post on 16.6.2015. He has submitted that the Applicant has completed the period of deputation on 15.6.2019. Before that he moved an application for giving one year extension to the Government. But the Government has not yet taken decision on the application. He has submitted that meanwhile, the Desk Officer of State Information Commission, Bench at Aurangabad issued relieving order dated 29.06.2019.

4. He has submitted that the Desk Officer is not empowered to issue the said order and therefore, he prayed to quash and set aside the order dated 29.6.2019.

5. Learned C.P.O. for the Respondents has submitted that the Applicant has completed his deputation period. Therefore, he has been relieved from the deputation post. The said order has been issued by the Desk Officer, State Information Commission, bench at Aurangabad with the approval of the Commissioner, State Information Commission and therefore, there is no illegality in the impugned order. He has submitted that the Applicant has already been relieved from the office of State Information Commission. Therefore, no question of granting of one year extension arises. Therefore, he prayed to reject the Original Application.

6. On perusal of record it reveals that the Applicant has been deputed for the period of 4 years in the office of State Information Commission, bench at Aurangabad. His deputation period has been completed on 15.6.2019. No extension has been given to him by the Government for further deputation in the office of State Information Commission. Therefore, the State Information Commission decided to relieve the Applicant and with the approval of Commissioner of State Information Commission, the Desk Officer, State Information Commission, bench at Aurangabad issued relieving order dated 29.06.2019.

7. Prima facie, I find no illegality in the said impugned order. The Applicant has already been relieved from the said post. Therefore, no question of granting of further extension arises. Therefore, request to grant interim relief is rejected.

8. Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 14.08.2019.

9. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

10. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

11. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

12. The service may be done by hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgment be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry before due date. Applicant is directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.

13. If notice is not collected within 7 days or proof of service is not produced before 3 days of the next date, case shall automatically stand dismissed without further reference to the Tribunal.

Heard Shri J.M. Murkute, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri N.U. Yadav, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. In the present matter, the deceased Government employee Smt. Shakuntalabai Kandere who was serving as Sweeper died on 24.04.1991. No heir as specified in the G.R. dated 10.11.2015 and 11.03.2016 was survived by her at the time of her death. The Applicant who is claiming her heir has to file an application for compassionate appointment within one year from date of death of the class-4 employee working on the post of Sweeper. The present Applicant is granddaughter of the deceased government employee. It seems that the present Applicant is born after the death of the deceased employee.

3. On perusal of various G.R.s produced by the Respondents i.e. G.R. dated 26.02.2014 and 10.11.2015 it reveals that grandson/granddaughter are not listed in the heirs eligible to get appointment after death of class-4 government employee working on the post of Sweeper.

4. Therefore, the Applicant is not eligible to claim employment under the said provision/scheme. Therefore, claim of the Applicant is not maintainable. Moreover, the Applicant has moved the application beyond the period of limitation as stipulated in the G.R.

5. In these circumstances, in my opinion, there is no merit in the present Original Application. Hence, the Original Application stands rejected. No order as to costs.
