 - (b) In view of settled position of Law the charge sheet issued belatedly deserves to be quashed.
 - (c) The impugned charge-sheet is issued vexatiously and due to malafides.
9. Though we want entire O.A. to be replied for the purpose of hearing on interim relief, Respondent shall be free to file limited affidavit on foregoing points as stated in paragraph 8.
10. Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondent prays for two week's time for filing reply.
11. Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, the learned Advocate for the Applicant opposes the grant of time on the ground that officers are showing extra-ordinary hurry and is taking action against applicant in haste in taking decision adverse to the Applicant and therefore, he insist on immediate hearing on interim relief.

12. Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, the learned Presenting Officer is called to take instructions on following points :-

- (a) How much time is required for filing reply ?
- (b) In case Government wants longer time would the Government stay its hand for taking final action against the Applicant in the matter of final action in the matter of impugned charges.

14. This order will not preclude the Respondents from filing the affidavit-in-reply on all grounds and averments of the O.A. at the earliest.
