The Applicant contends that he worked as Van Majoor from 01.11.1999 to 30.06.2004 and was eligible for absorption in terms of G.R. dated 16.10.2012. the Applicant has placed on record the information collected under RTI which shows that he had worked for more than 240 days only in three years i.e. 1994, 1995 and 1998. Apart, he has produced the certificates issued by RFO dated 01.11.1999 showing that he worked for more than 240 days in the year 1996 as well as in 1999. On the basis of these, the Applicant sought to contend that he had worked for more than 240 days for five years and he is eligible for absorption.</p> <p>4. Whether the Applicant has really worked for 240 days for five years in terms of G.R. dated 16.10.2012 is the question of fact which needs to be decided by Respondent No.1 in first place.</p>

5. As such, the Applicant is required to make representation to the Respondent No.1 for claiming relief of absorption in terms of G.R. dated 16.10.2012. However, no such representation seems to have been made.

6. Learned Counsel for the Applicant, therefore, seeks permission to withdraw the O.A. with liberty to file representation to the Respondent No.1 for absorption.

7. O.A. is, therefore, disposed of in following terms :-

(A) The liberty is granted to the Applicant to make representation to the Respondent No.1 within two weeks from today and if such representation is made, it shall be decided by the Respondent No.1 within a month from the date of receipt of the representation.

(B) The decision as the case may be shall be communicated to the Applicant within a week thereafter.

(C) If the Applicant felt aggrieved by the decision, he may avail further legal course of action as permissible in law.

(D) No order as to costs.


