The Applicant has challenged the impugned order dated 26.11.2019 whereby the recovery of Rs.7,97,035/- is sought from retiral benefits. The Applicant is due to retire in February, 2020. It appears that excess amount was paid to him due to wrong fixation of pay-scale and grant of Time Bound Benefits. 3. Prima-facie, the Applicant being Group-C employee and retiring within a year, the recovery is not permissible in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in <u>Rafiq Masih (White Washer) dated 18th December, 2014 (to be hereinafter called Rafiq Masih's case).</u> 4. Interim relief in terms of Paragraph No.11(a) of O.A. is granted. 5. Issue notice before admission returnable on 03.02.2020. 6. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued. 7. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing. 8. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open. 9. 




