2. The applicant has filed the present Original Application to direct the respondents to consider his pension case in view of the Rule 110 (3) of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982.

3. It is contention of the applicant that he rendered service as Talathi for 9 years, 6 months and 18 days. He applied to the respondents for condoning the deficiency in view of Rule 54 of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982 and to make an addition in service. The said proposal is pending with the respondent No. 1 since 03.01.2009, but no decision had been take on it by the respondent No. 1. Therefore, he

approached this Tribunal and prayed to direct the respondents to decide his claim to grant pensionary benefits to him.

4. Respondent No. 2 has filed his affidavit in reply and admitted said facts. It is his contention that the proposal has been forwarded to the respondent No. 1 and the decision from the respondent No. 1 is awaited and on receiving the decision from the respondent No. 1, the pension papers of the applicant will be preceded further.

5. Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the proposal sent by the respondent No. 2 is pending with the respondent No. 1 since 03.01.2009, but the respondent No. 1 had not taken decision on it. Therefore, he prayed to direct the respondent No. 1 to decide the proposal forwarded by the respondent No. 2 in that regard within a stipulated time.

6. Learned Presenting Officer has prayed to pass necessary orders.

7. On perusal of the record, it reveals that the applicant rendered service as Talathi for 9 years, 6 months and 18 days. He has not rendered 10 years qualifying service for grant of pension and pensionary benefits. The Rule 54 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982 provides the Government may condone a deficiency and make an addition in service in the period of service of qualifying for pension of Government servant to qualify him to receive pension and gratuity. The proposal in that regard has been forwarded by the respondent No. 2 to the respondent No. 1 on 03.01.2009, but no decision has been taken by the respondent No. 1 till today. Therefore, it is just and proper to direct the respondent No. 1 to decide the proposal sent by the respondent No. 2 on 03.01.2009 to extend the benefits to the applicant in view of Rule 54 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982 and grant pensionary benefits to the applicant within a period of three months from the date of this order.

8. In view thereof, the Original Application stands disposed of with a direction to the respondent No. 1 to take decision on the proposal sent by the respondent No. 2 for extending benefits in view of Rule 54 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982 and grant pensionary benefits to the applicant within a period of three months from the date of this order and communicate the decision therein to the applicant in writing. There shall be no order as to costs.
