Applicant has filed present O.A. for directions to release retiral benefits. He was suspended on 05.02.1996 in view of registration of crime under prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. He was convicted by Special Court on 05.03.2003. Consequently by order dated 28.01.2005, he was dismissed from service in view of his conviction invoking Rule 13 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules 1979. Against the judgment of conviction, the Applicant had preferred an appeal before the Hon'ble High Court which came to be allowed by judgment dated 09.06.2016 resulting into acquittal. After acquittal, the Applicant has made various representations dated 26.07.2016, 21.11.2016, 12.01.2017, 03.03.2017, and 20.04.2017. It appears that there was only correspondence between the department on the issue but nothing was materialized and the Applicant is left without retiral benefits though stands retired on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.01.2015.</p>

	<p>3. Thus, conviction in the Criminal Case was the only ground for dismissal and conviction is set aside. Now, the Respondents are required to pass appropriate order about retiral benefits of the Applicant which are not passed though the period of more than four years is over. As such, there seems to be no legal hurdle to withhold the retiral benefits of the Applicant.</p> <p>4. Learned P.O. submits that department is seeking opinion from Anti Corruption Bureau about filing of Special Leave Petition (SLP) against the judgment of acquittal delivered by the Hon'ble High Court.</p> <p>5. Indeed, four years time has already over but no SLP has filed. This shows that Anti Corruption Bureau does not want to file SLP. Therefore, the retiral benefits of the Applicant cannot be withheld only on the ground that instructions are being taken about filing of SLP.</p> <p>6. In view of above, Original Application deserves to be disposed of with suitable directions. Hence the following order.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>ORDER</u></p> <p>(A) Original Application is disposed of with direction to the Respondents to decide representations made by the Applicant referred to above and release retiral benefits of the Applicant as per his entitlement in accordance to rules within four weeks from today.</p> <p>(B) Applicant is at liberty to make representation to the department for interest on delayed payment.</p> <p>(C) As the Applicant has been constrained to file O.A. due to inaction on part of department to take decision on his representations, I am inclined to saddle cost of Rs.10,000/- on Respondents.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sd/- (A.P. I attach considerable significance to the fact that the Respondent did not get themselves armed with permission to continue the DE after the time limit fixed by this Tribunal even in MA 370/2013 expired. Once a particular direction is given by a judicial authority to act in a particular manner as regards the time frame within which the work must be completed, then the authorities concerned have no freedom to freely and at will violate the said condition. The above discussion must have made it quite clear that the Respondents treated the whole matter casually and exhibited a tendency to show as if there was no direction issued by the Tribunal. The fact that their move had once succeeded should in fact have guided them to make sure that they acted within the time stipulated and if it was absolutely impossible for them to do so, then at least to seek a further extension of time. I am not prepared to dismiss all these aspects of the matter as technical. 

