Learned counsel submits that on 15.7.2020, a Circular was issued by the Under Secretary, Home Department of India, requesting all Chief Secretary of the State to nominate 10 names of for the Mission. Learned counsel further submitted that while preparing the list of 14 nominees, two Police Inspectors who are of 55 years and whose tenure is less than 3 years are also included. Learned counsel submits that earlier his name was included in the first list, however, it was dropped subsequently.
