2. Learned Advocate for the Applicant submitted that the delay of five months posed in filing O.A. is not deliberate and further urged that in view of acquittal of the Applicant in the Criminal Case which was the reason for suspension of the Applicant, he has good case on merit and, therefore, requested to condone the delay.

3. Whereas the leaned P.O. for the Respondents submitted that the delay is not properly explained and, therefore, even the delay is of short period, it cannot be condoned.

4. Perusal of the record reveals that the Applicant was suspended in view of the registration of crime u/s 376 and 506 of I.P.C. He was accordingly prosecuted in Sessions Case No.98/2011. However, he has been acquitted by the judgment dated 14.07.2015. After acquittal, the impugned order dated 29.08.2017 has been passed by the Disciplinary Authority whereby the suspension period from 15.04.2011 to 08.09.2015 has been treated as suspension period. Being aggrieved by this order, the Applicant has filed the present D.A. along with application for condonation of delay.

5. Though enough time is granted, the Respondents failed to file reply.

6. Needless to mention that while considering the application for condonation of delay, the Tribunal should not adopt higher technical approach and if there is no inordinate delay then it has to be condoned to decide the matter on merit. There seems to be no intentional delay in filing O.A.

7. Hence, for the reasons stated in M.A. the application for condonation of delay is allowed.

8. In view of, the Misc. Application is disposed of with no order as to costs.
