

In the present matter, the Applicant is left without posting for more than four months and despite the interim orders as well as final order passed by the Tribunal in O.A.No.804/2019, no remedial measures are taken. Indeed, in O.A. the Principal Secretary, Public Health Department had filed an Affidavit on 13.09.2019 and tendered unconditional apology. He admits that there is failure on part of his office to verify the fact before issuance of order of the transfer of the Applicant. The Applicant was transferred by order dated 31.05.2019 and directed to join as Medical Officer, Shelpimpalgaon, Tal. Khed, Dist. Pune. However, when he went to join at the place of posting given to him, it was noticed that another person Shri Rajendra Mohite was already posted there by order dated 11.10.2018 and was working since 20.10.2018. As such, it was the case of transfer without verifying whether the post on which the Applicant was transferred is really vacant.
4. As stated above, the Principal Secretary, Public Health Department admits that the office has not verified the facts, and therefore, wrong posting order was issued. It is on this background, the Tribunal has disposed of the O.A. on 20.09.2019 with directions to pass appropriate order of posting within two weeks. At the time to passing of the order, the Tribunal was also inclined to impose the cost but the cost was not imposed in view of submission made by the learned C.P.O. that posting order will be issued soon.
5. Despite aforesaid position, the posting order is not issued. It is thus apparent that the Respondents have no regard to the order passed by the Tribunal and they are taking the orders of the Tribunal casually. This needs to be handled sternly.
6. In view of above, issue notice to Principal Secretary, Public Health Department as to why contempt proceedings should not be initiated against him returnable on 15.10.2019.

It appears that he was suspended for failure to maintain and produce relevant record in the matter of enquiry against Smt. Khairnar.</p> <p>3. After suspension, the Applicant made representation to reinstate him in service but in vain. Therefore, ultimately he has filed the present O.A. challenging the suspension order contending that same is illegal.</p> <p>4. Though enough chances are granted to the Respondents, no reply is filed in D.A.</p> <p>5. Learned Counsel for the Applicant has produced the order dated 21.07.2019 which shows that suspension of the Applicant is revoked and he is reinstated in service. However, while giving posting, he was posted as Warden, Government Tribal Boys Hostel, Alangun, Tal. Surgana, Dist. Nashik whereas at the time of suspension he was Warden at Boys Hostel, Manur, Tal. Kalwan, Dist. Nashik.</p>

6. Having heard the submissions advanced by learned Counsel for the Applicant as well as learned C.P.O. for the Respondents, the present matter can be disposed of with suitable directions as the Applicant is already reinstated in service and at the same time no reply is filed by the Respondents to challenge the suspension.

7. Needless to mention that in case of suspension, the Disciplinary Authority is required to complete the D.E. within six months which is not followed in the present matter. Even it is not clear whether the department intend to initiate the charge sheet against the Applicant. This being the position, the matter cannot be kept in abeyance and the Disciplinary Authority is required to decide whether to initiate D.E. and if decides to initiate the D.E. then it should be completed expeditiously so that it has taken to the logical conclusion.

8. In view of above, O.A. is disposed of with no order as to costs with following directions. Hence, the following order :-

ORDER

(A) Respondent No.1 who is Disciplinary Authority is directed to take decision as to whether he wants to initiate D.E. against the Applicant within two months from today. If, he decides to initiate D.E. against the Applicant then charge sheet be issued immediately and D.E. should be completed within four months thereafter.

(B) If the Respondent No.1 fails to take decision of initiation of D.E. within two months, in that event, D.E. deem to have been dropped and the Applicant will be entitled to posting at the same place.
