ORDER

1. Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicants and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. At the outset Ld. PO has tendered for perusal copy of minutes of Police Establishment Board (PEB) in which the decision to transfer applicants in present group was taken. Ld. PO was directed to furnish copy of minutes of PEB to Ld. Advocate for the applicants, which was accordingly furnished.
3. After perusal of the minutes of PEB, Ld. Advocate for the applicants prays for leave to amend which he considers necessary.



4. Leave to amend as prayed is granted. Ld. Advocate for applicants undertakes to carry out the amendment on or before 15.1.2018.
5. Issue fresh notice after amendment returnable on 24.1.2018.
6. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal need not be issued.
7. Applicants are authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
8. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
9. The service may be done by hand delivery/ speed post/courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicants are directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.
10. In case notice is not collected within three days and if service report on affidavit is not filed three days before returnable date, OA shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.
11. Various points raised by Ld. Advocate for the applicants in the OAs and orally addressed which the applicants wish to introduce by amendment, go to the root and raise serious questions.

12. Instead of entering into routine form of securing a reply and loosing time, it is considered necessary that directions be given to the Commissioner of Police, Thane that he shall personally look into the matter for which he should read the OAs himself, apply mind and take a policy decision as to whether some corrective steps is necessary or it would be proper to simply proceed to contest the OAs.

13. Therefore, the Commissioner of Police, Thane is directed as follows:

- (i) He shall call for papers of the OAs.
- (ii) Read the same personally and after reading discuss about the merits of the case with the Ld. CPO/PO as well as Members of the PEB.
- (iii) After reading and formation of opinion, he should decide his stance as to whether he would like to reconsider the matter or enter the contest.
- (iv) If he chooses to contest, he shall be free to file reply on the next date, when OAs would be heard and decided.

4. Applicants are authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

5. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
