4. Applicant has approached this Tribunal in the background that, applicant was appointed by order dated 21.12.2016 as a bonded candidate after due selection.
5. Applicant was again appointed by another order dated 02.04.2017.
6. Now applicant apprehends termination because the office of D.M.E.R. has released a list of a bonded candidate to be appointed in the post held by the applicant though, the bonded candidate Shri Salve Rahul Rangnath to be now appointed does not fulfill the eligibility norms.
7. Applicant has not shown any evidence to support her contentions as regards lack of eligibility of Shri Salve Rahul Rangnath.
8. Applicants both orders of appointment contain following conditions:-

9. From the foregoing quotations it is evident that applicant has no right to continue. More other bonded Doctors have to be engaged in larger interest.
10. Right of applicant is already ruled out by judgement of **D.B. of Hon'ble High Court bench Nagpur in W.P. No. 4953, 4954 & 5097 all of 2933 dated 9.10.2013 (Coram Smt. Vasanti A. Naik & A.S. Chandurkar, JJ.)**.
11. Hence applicant request for Interim Relief is refused.

Respondents</p> <p>I have perused the record and the file furnished for my perusal on behalf of the Respondents.</p> <p>I have heard Smt. Lata Patane, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri N.K. Rajpurohit, the learned C.P.O. for the Respondents.</p> <p>The Applicant was subjected to mid tenure transfer and, therefore, there is a mandate of Sections 4(4) and 4(5) of the Transfer Act, which must be complied with. The Tribunal must ensure with regard to the existence of special reasons and exceptional circumstances. Although the learned C.P.O. points out the first two pages in support of his contention that the said requirement was complied with. I find that in the first page, there is some kind of a summary of the Transfer Act and even in the second page there is nothing about the facts that constituted special reasons and exceptional circumstances in so far as the Applicant is concerned. In this set of circumstances, the Applicant cannot be left unprotected. Even if the Applicant may have been relieved the order of reposting her even if it tantamounts to mandatory order of interlocutory stage can be made. It is specifically directed that except for the place the Applicant would be reposted at, the private Respondent being the Respondent No.3 is free to be posted at any place considered proper. With this, the Respondents are directed to repost the Applicant to Sub-District Hospital, Baramati within one week from today.</p>

Issue notice returnable on 07.09.2017.

Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal need not be issued.

Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988 and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

J U D G M E N T

1. Heard Shri Uday Bobde, learned Advocate for the Applicants and Smt. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. These MAs were heard from time to time, because MA No.505 of 2016 for restoration of TA has been filed by the applicants after long span of 13 years. The facts are eloquent and brief.

3. The applicants had approached Hon'ble High Court by filing Writ Petition No.2455 of 1996. The writ petition was admitted and interim relief in terms of prayer clause (f) was granted on 6.9.1990. Said prayer clause (f) reads as follows:

“(f) Pending the hearing and final disposal of this Writ Petition, this Hon'ble Court may by an mandatory interim order and/or injunction or to continue the Petitioners in same Government service prior to passing of the termination order of service dated 31.7.1990 and served on them on 1.8.1990 under the Discipline Control Recruitment Rules or any receiving the right to the state of taking any other lawful action order to be taken and are passed against the Petitioners in the event they are found guilty under the provisions of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline and Control and Recruitment) Rules or any other prescribes Rules.”

4. The writ petition was transferred to this Tribunal after its constitution. The transferred Writ Petition No.2455 of 1996 was registered as Transfer Application No.48 of 1993.
5. None appeared in spite of notice from this Tribunal. Therefore, the TA was dismissed for default by order dated 29.9.1997.
6. This Tribunal proceeded on the belief that applicants had failed to appear and pursue the matter in spite of service of notice. The record shows that there is an endorsement of the office which reads as follows:

“Notices were issued to all parties on 22.7.96 by R.P.A.D.
Still ADs have not been received by the office.”
7. Applicants claim that a notice of this Tribunal upon transfer of registration of transferred writ petition as Transfer Application was not received by applicants.
8. The record does not show that writ of dismissal and vacation of stay was issued to the respondents.
9. It is fact of common knowledge of the applicants as well as the respondents, that in spite of dismissal of TA, the applicants continued to avail and enjoy benefit and consequence of the interim order granted by the Hon'ble High Court. Applicants continued to serve and respondents never objected to the continuation of the applicants in the employment even till few amongst them attained age of superannuation. Admittedly, four amongst applicants are still continuing in service.
10. It is thus evident that applicants as well as respondents did not have knowledge of the fact that T.A. No.48 of 1993 was dismissed. The

delay of 19 years caused in filing MA No.504 of 2016 for condonation of delay as well as MA No.505 of 2016 for restoration of TA, is well supported by the ground that both parties laboured under honest belief that the TA No.48 of 1993 was still pending.

11. Applicants' version that they did not receive notice of this Tribunal can be accepted, since acknowledgments of Registered notice were not received in the office of this Tribunal. The State has no say on this aspect.

12. Therefore, delay of 19 years caused in filing of both MAs is explained by the applicants satisfactorily and though opposed, fact that the respondents too were not aware of dismissal of TA for default is not denied by the respondents.

13. Hence, the delay of 19 years in filing the application for restoration is condoned. MA for restoration is allowed. By this common order MA No.504 of 2016 and MA No.505 of 2016 are allowed.

14. The said dismissal order dated 29.9.1997 passed by this Tribunal is recalled, and TA No.48 of 1993 is restored to file.

15. The applicants undertake to reconstruct record of the TA within thirty days which be done by filing fresh paper book. TA be listed for final hearing.



the Applicant.
