3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant has submitted that the Applicant could not able to submit the service affidavit in the O.A. in time and therefore, it came to be dismissed on 10.01.2019. He has submitted that valuable rights of the Applicant are involved in the Original Application and therefore, he has prayed to restore the O.A. by allowing the Misc. Application and by condoning the delay caused for filing the restoration application.

4. Learned P.O. has submitted that the Original Application has been dismissed on 10.01.2019. The Applicant ought to have filed the application for restoration within 30 days from the date of dismissal order in view of the Rule 16(2) of Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988.

She has submitted that there is no rule to condone the delay caused for filing the restoration application. Therefore, she prayed to reject the Misc. Application.

5. On perusal of record it reveals that the Applicant filed the O.A.No.899/2018 and it came to be dismissed in default on 10.01.2019 as he had not complied the direction given by this Tribunal in the order dated 5.12.2018. In view of the provision of Rule 16(2) of Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, the Applicant has to move the application for restoration within 30 days. Rule 16(2) reads as follows:-

“16 (2) Where an application has been dismissed for default and the applicant files an application within thirty days from the date of dismissal and satisfies the Tribunal that there was sufficient cause for his non-appearance when the application was called for hearing, the Tribunal shall make an order setting aside the order dismissing the application and restore the same.”

6. The Applicant has not filed the present Misc. Application within 30 days as provided in Rule 16(2) of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988. There is no provision in the above said Rules to condone the delay caused for filing the restoration application. Therefore, the application is not maintainable. Not only this but also there is no just ground for setting aside the order of dismissal.
