Tata Marg, Churchgate, Mumbai.

5. As per Rule 6 of Administrative Tribunal Act (Procedure) Rules 1985, the Original Application ought to have been filed either at Aurangabad or Nagpur in terms of Clause (1) and (2) of above Rules, 1985.

6. In view of the above I find no substance in the submission of learned Advocate Shri A.V. Sakolkar for the Applicant and hence O.A. be returned to the Applicant for proper presentation.

When this matter was taken up on 03.01.2019 for first order, that time itself, the learned P.O. Shri Chougule raised leave of jurisdiction contending that the Applicant is not State Government employee, and therefore, this Tribunal has no jurisdiction. In view of his objection, on the request of learned Advocate for the Applicant, the matter was adjourned for today.</li><li>4. Today, the learned P.O. has produced a Judgment in O.A.No.474/2006 (Abdul Rashid Vs. State of Maharashtra) decided on 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2017, whereby for want of jurisdiction, the application was returned to the Applicant for being presented before appropriate forum having jurisdiction. In that case, the Applicant was the employee of Maharashtra Maritime Board. The Tribunal accepted the contention of Maharashtra Maritime Board that the employees who were allotted to the Maharashtra Maritime Board after 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2003, ceases to be Government servant and they became the employees of the Maharashtra Maritime Board under Maharashtra Maritime Board Act, 1986. Thus, their service conditions are being governed by Maharashtra Maritime Board Act, 1996. The Tribunal, therefore, concluded that it has no jurisdiction to entertain the application filed by the employee of Maharashtra Maritime Board.</li></ol>
