Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted the applicant has applied for the post of Craft Instructor in pursuance of the advertisement at Annexure A-14, paper book page 87 issued by the Respondent no.5 Deputy Director, Vocational Education and Training, Regional Office, Pune. He has submitted that as per the advertisement the required qualification for the post of Craft Instructor has been mentioned and it is mentioned that the candidates who successfully completed training in the Central Training Institute (CTI) for the post of Instructor may be given preference. He has submitted that the said condition is against the guidelines given by the Central Government as well as the State Government.

3. Learned Advocate for the applicant has further submitted that the Deputy Director, Vocational Education and Training by letter dated 23-12-2019 communicated to all concerned to follow direction given by the Central Government. He has submitted that without considering the said directions the impugned advertisement has been issued and thereafter recruitment process has been conducted. He has submitted that in fact as per the directions of State Government and Central Government, it is mandatory to complete the CTI training for the post of Craft Instructor. He has submitted that as the advertisement is in violation of the guidelines given by the State Government and Central Government, the recruitment process is illegal. He has submitted that the respondents declared result of the recruitment process and declared some of the candidates as successful candidates but they do not possess CTI qualification and therefore he has prayed to grant interim relief and prayed to direct the respondents not to give appointment to the selected candidates till decision of the O.A.

4. Learned PO has submitted that the recruitment process has been conducted in pursuance of the advertisement which is at Annexure A-14, paper book page 87 issued by the Respondent no.5 Deputy Director, Vocational Education and Training, Regional Office, Pune. She has submitted that the applicant had applied for the post of Craft Instructor. He appeared for written examination held on 12-01-2020 and 13-01-2020. He has not passed the written examination, therefore, he was not called for further process. Since the applicant has participated in the recruitment process, he cannot challenge the same. Therefore, she prayed to reject the request of the applicant to grant interim relief. She has submitted that the applicant has not made selected candidates as party respondent in the matter and therefore in their absence interim relief cannot be granted in favour of the applicant and O.A. cannot be decided in their absence. She has accordingly prayed to reject the request for interim relief.

5. On perusal of record, it reveals that the recruitment process was conducted in pursuance of

the advertisement issued by the respondent no.5. The applicant participated in the recruitment process. He appeared for the written examination conducted on 12-01-2020 and 13-01-2020. He was not successful in the written examination and therefore he was not called for further process. Thereafter, the select list has been published by the respondents. The applicant has not made the selected candidates as party respondents in the O.A. They will be aggrieved persons in case any order is passed against them by the Tribunal in the present O.A. It is necessary to give them an opportunity of hearing before passing any order. The applicant ought to have joined them as party respondents in the O.A. In their absence O.A. cannot be decided effectively. The applicant participated in the recruitment. He has not succeeded in the written examination.

6. Therefore, in these circumstances, in my view it is not a fit case to grant interim relief in favour of the applicant. Hence, the prayer of the applicant for interim relief is rejected.
