The respondent no.1 has also given an undertaking that necessary action will be taken within four weeks. In fact there is no direction from this Tribunal fixing any time limit. It is not understood as to how this present MA for extension of time is maintainable when this Tribunal has never fixed any time limit to implement the aforesaid order. The undertaking was given by respondent no.1.

3. MA No.167 of 2016 for condonation of delay as well as MA No.168 of 2016 for extension of time to implement the order of this Tribunal are dismissed as having no merit.

2. This MA is presented by the applicants-original respondents seeking extension of time to comply with the interim order made by Single Bench presided over by one of us [Shri R.B. Malik, Member (J)] on 10.2.2016. The respondents-original applicants are represented by their advocate Shri Bandiwadekar.

3. Now, perusal of the record shows that the Tribunal was not quite approving of the manner in which the State went about complying with its order and ultimately keeping the OA pending directions were given by order dated 5.1.2016 read with order dated 12.1.2016 effectively directing that even as the efforts may continue to settle the matter of all similarly placed employees but in case of the present applicants compliance must be made within three months. It is that time limit for which extension is hereby sought. Shri Bandiwadekar, Ld. Advocate has made his submissions indicating inter alia that he has no objection if the extension is granted provided the respondents were to act with due dispatch. As the matter came to be debated at the bar it came about that the direction as hereinbelow needs to be given so that the State gets time and at the same time the respondents-original applicants are not compelled to wait indefinitely. This MA is disposed off with a direction that the compliance with the interim order be made by 28.6.2016 and in case the compliance is not made without any further directions or orders the OA itself will be heard finally on 30.6.2016. No order as to costs. Hamdast.
