ORDER

1. Heard Smt Punam Mahajan along with Shri A. V. Sakolkar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A. J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. In the present O.A., the Applicant has challenged the suspension order dated 09.04.2019 invoking the Rule 4(2)(b) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979.
3. The perusal of the record reveals that in private complaint (Summary Criminal Case No.129/2010), the Applicant was one of the accused. The Learned Judicial Magistrate First Class (JMFC), Jamkhed by judgment dated 27.03.2019 sentenced the Applicant and convicted for the offence u/s 323 r/w 34 of I.P.C. and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment of three months and fine of Rs.500/-. On the same day, the Applicant filed an application for suspension of sentence as well as grant of bail. Accordingly, on the same day, learned JMFC suspended the sentence and released the Applicant on bail of Rs.15,000/-. The Applicant had also filed Criminal Appeal No.79/2019 in Sessions Court, Ahmednagar wherein the learned Sessions Judge stayed the conviction of the Applicant by order dated 10.04.2019.
4. Perusal of suspension order dated 09.04.2019 reveals that the reason for suspension was conviction of Applicant in Criminal Case No.129/2010.
5. On the above background, learned Advocate for the Applicant submitted that the sentence as well as conviction being stayed by the court, the impugned suspension order is ex-

facie illegal as ingredients of Rule 4(2) (b) read with explanation to it are not at all attracted in the present matter.

6. Rule 4(2)(b) and explanation is as follows:-

Rule 4(2)(b) : A Government servant shall be deemed to have been placed under suspension by an order of appointing authority-

(b) With effect from the date of his conviction, if, in the event of a conviction for an offence, he is sentenced to a term of imprisonment exceeding forty-eight hours and is not forthwith dismissed or removed or compulsorily retired consequent to such conviction.

Explanation – The period of forty-eight hours referred to in Clause (b) of this sub-rule shall be computed from the commencement of the imprisonment after the conviction and for this purpose, intermittent periods of imprisonment, if any, shall be taken into account.

7. Whereas the learned P.O. tried to contend that in view of the order of conviction by the learned JMFC, the impugned suspension order cannot be faulted with. According to him, subsequent stay to the conviction by the Sessions Court, Ahmednagar on 10.04.2019 will not invalidate the suspension order dated 09.04.2019.

8. There is no denying that the Applicant was convicted by the learned JMFC by order dated 27.03.2019 and on the same day, learned JMFC was pleased to suspend the sentence and the Applicant was released on bail. As such, there is no actual imprisonment of the Applicant as his sentence has been stayed. Beside, by order dated 10.04.2019, the Sessions Court by passing detailed order stayed the conviction and released the Applicant on bail till the decision of appeal. Therefore, as of now the conviction is not in force and it being specifically stayed by the Sessions Court, it does not invite action like suspension.

9. In view of above, *prima-facie* the suspension order has been issued without considering the orders passed by the learned JMFC staying the operation of sentence of the Applicant. This being the position, *prima-facie* case is made out to grant stay to the suspension order dated 09.04.2019.

10. By way of interim relief, implementation of suspension order dated 09.04.2019 is stayed till further orders.
11. Issue notice before admission returnable on 06.06.2019.
12. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
13. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
14. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
