2. Vide order dated 09.01.2019 the Registrar of this Tribunal was pleased to refuse the registration under Rule 5 (4) of Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedural) Rules, 1988. On 01.12.2018 the office has raised the following office objections in M.A. St. 2003/2018: -

- 1) Age of respondents not mentioned.
- 2) Page Nos. 10 to 13, 18, 27 to 29, 31 & 33 are black.
- 3) Detailed address of respondent No. 2 is not given.

3. The learned Advocate for the applicant appeared today and has undertaken to remove the office objections raised by this office in M.A. today only.

4. Technically the Registrar was right in refusing the registration of M.A. since nobody appeared for the applicant to remove the office objections in spite of repeated chances. The learned counsel for the

applicant submits that he could not attend the Tribunal due to his personal difficulty and, therefore, the registration was refused. The fact that the M.A. is filed for giving false reply affidavit on oath before Hon'ble Court and in order to give an opportunity to the applicant to prove his claim on merits, it will be in the interest of justice to allow the appeal as the applicant shall not suffer for the negligence of his Advocate.

5. There is delay of about 11 days in filing chamber appeal. Learned Advocate for the applicant prays for condonation of delay caused in filing chamber appeal.

6. In view of the above, I pass the following order:

ORDER

(i) Delay of about 11 days caused in filing chamber appeal is hereby condoned.

(ii) Chamber Appeal No. 02/2019 is allowed as the applicant has undertaken to remove the office objections raised by the office in M.A. today itself. Registrar of this Tribunal Bench at Aurangabad is directed to place M.A. before the appropriate Bench for hearing.
