Patil V/s State of Maharashtra & Ors</i>, decided on 18.07.2017 and <i>W.P.No.695/2016 Prabhakar Mare & Ors. V/s State of Maharashtra & Ors.</i> decided on 12.02.2018 wherein directions for refund of the amount were issued. The Applicant seems to be similarly situated person.</p> <p>5. In view of above, learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that Original Application be disposed of with directions to Respondent No.1 to decide the representation made by the Applicant dated 09.03.2017 in view of the decision referred to above.</p> <p>6.
