In the present matter, the challenge is to the impugned order dated 23.10.2017 whereby the suspension period of the applicant from 02.05.2005 to 17.02.2010 was declared to be considered as duty period but with 90% of the pay and allowances.</p> <p>2. The Applicant was prosecuted in Special Criminal Case No.73/2003 for the offence u/s 7, 13, 1(d) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. He was acquitted by the learned Special Judge on 26.06.2009. Thereafter, the impugned order dated 23.10.2017 has been passed after giving show cause notice to him.</p> <p>3. At the midst of hearing, Shri A. V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant has pointed out that the learned Special Judge after acquitting the Applicant had issued notices of perjury to two witnesses in pursuance of the observations made by him in the judgment. These two witnesses were turned hostile and, therefore, the learned Judge thought it fit to issue notices of perjury against them as to why action for giving false evidence should not be initiated against them. They have submitted their explanations before the learned Judge. After considering the same, the learned Judge dropped the perjury proceeding by order dated 30.04.2010 as seen from the copies of the proceedings filed by the learned Advocate for the Applicant which are marked by letter 'X' for identification purpose.</p>

Smt. Archana B. K., the learned P.O. submitted that this fact of closure of perjury proceeding was not brought before the Competent Authority who passed the impugned order. In the present matter, the challenge is to the suspension order dated 16.07.2018 whereby the Applicant was kept under suspension in contemplation of D.E. invoking the Rule 4(1)(a) of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline &amp; Appeal) Rules, 1979.</p> <p>3. The Applicant has approached this Tribunal on the ground that though the period of more than six months is over, neither D.E. is completed nor review of the suspension has been taken by the Disciplinary Authority. It is further pointed out by learned Advocate for the Applicant that in terms of judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in <b>(2015) 7 SCC 291 (Ajay Kumar Choudhary Vs. Union of India &amp; Anr.)</b>, suspension beyond 90 days is illegal.</p> <p>4. In view of the fact of the present case, it is quite clear that there is no compliance of instructions contained in G.R. dated 14.10.2011 which mandates the review of suspension after three months and secondly, the D.E. has to be completed within six months from the date of suspension. Besides, the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in <b>Ajaykumar Choudhary's</b> case (cited supra) needs to be considered.</p> <p>5. Learned P.O. for the Respondents requests for two weeks time to take instructions and to file reply.</p>

6. As a very short point is involved, seven days time is granted to the learned P.O. to take instructions on the above referred aspect as observed by the Tribunal and make submission on the next date.
7. Issue notice before admission returnable on 22.02.2019.
8. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.


