ORDER

1. Heard Shri M.D Lonkar, learned advocate for the Applicant and Ms Swati Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. Applicant has challenged impugned transfer order dated 20.7.2017, Exh. 'F', page 29 by which applicant has been transferred and posted at a vacant post as Additional Chief Executive Officer, District-Wardha.
3. Case proceeds on the following background:-
 - (i) Applicant's transfer is mid-term and mid-tenure.
 - (ii) Reasons have not been recorded for issuing transfer in mid-term.
 - (iii) Applicant was holding additional charge apart from his post of Project Director, D.R.D.A, Sangli and though applicant is transferred, no one is posted in his place as Project Director, D.R.D.A.
 - (iv) Applicant's daughter Ruchi A. Mane, 16 years is suffering from grave illness of some deformity in the brain and is totally parent dependent child.
4. In the midst of hearing, learned advocate for the applicant states as follows:-

“That if the applicant is retained at his present posting till end of April, 2018 he shall request for a convenient posting which may be considered and decided at the time of general transfer orders and shall obey the transfer order wherever he may be posted including impugned transfer order.”
5. Considering the grounds of challenge and statement of learned advocate for the applicant, taken together, an order shall

meet ends of justice, if direction is given to the Respondent to retain the applicant at his present posting and by deferring implementation of the impugned order till the general transfer season ensuing in April-May, 2018 and representation, if any, submitted by the applicant supported by medical evidence be given due and humanitarian consideration.

6. With above observations in the foregoing paragraph, Original Application is disposed of.


