1. Heard Shri K.R. Jagdale, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. The matter pertains to the resignation and reinstatement on the post of Kotwal. The Applicant had tendered resignation for the post of Kotwal but later withdrawn his resignation before acceptance within the period of 90 days.
3. However, by impugned order his resignation has accepted without considering his request to withdraw the same.
4. On the above background, the Applicant sought interim relief to stay the recruitment process initiated by the Respondent to fill in the post of Koltwal.
5. However, learned P.O. for the Respondents submitted that in view of new reservation policy declared by the Government of Maharashtra the recruitment process to fill in the post of Kotwal in Miraj Taluka has been cancelled and it will be initiated afresh.
6. As such, in view of the cancellation of recruitment process, at this stage, the question of interim relief does not survive.

7. Issue notice made returnable on 18.1.2019.
8. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
9. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

ORDER

1. Heard Shri S.S. Dere, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. In present O.A. challenge is to the impugned order dated 17.11.2018 whereby recovery of the increments paid from 13.8.1995 to 18.1.2015 sought to be made.
3. The Applicant is due to retire on 31.1.2019. The perusal of impugned order reveals that the Applicant has not cleared Marathi Language Examination within stipulated time and that seems to be reason for recovery of increments which have already paid to the Applicant. In view of this, the Applicant prays for interim relief in view of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No.11527 of 2014 in case of State of Punjab and other etc. Vs. Rafiq Masih (White Washer) etc decided on 18.12.2014.
4. Whereas, learned P.O. for the Respondents opposed the application of interim relief on the ground that the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court is not applicable in present fact as the Applicant has not yet retired.
5. At this stage, prima facie the situation is covered by the clause (ii), para no.12 of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court which mandates that recovery from the employee who are due to retire within one year, is not permissible.
6. This being a position, interim relief needs to be granted.

7. Interim relief is granted in terms of prayer clause 11.
8. Issue notice made returnable on 18.1.2019.
9. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.



4. At this stage, the Applicant also raised grievance that he has not received the interest on the delayed payment of Leave Encashment and Gratuity.

5. In so far as the interest part is concerned, the Applicant is required to first approach the Respondents by filing detailed representation claiming his entitlement to the interest, so that Department can take necessary action in accordance to Rules. Therefore, this application can be disposed of with following directions :

(A) The Applicant shall make detailed representation as regard his claim of interest on the delayed payment as well as other claims to Respondent No.3 within two weeks. On receipt of representation, the Respondent No.3 shall consider the same and take necessary action and if the Applicant is entitled, then he be paid in accordance to Rules within two months from the date of receipt of representation and communicate the decision to the Applicant.

(B) In case, the Applicant feels aggrieved by the decision, he may approach this Tribunal afresh in accordance with law.

3. However, today, again learned P.O. seeks two weeks' time to file reply. Interim relief granted on 7.12.2018 to continue.
