5. Learned P.O. for the Respondents states that the Applicant has not given sufficient and satisfactory reason for condoning the delay. Therefore, there is no just ground to condone the delay and therefore, he prayed to reject the Misc. Application.

6. On perusal of record it reveals that the son and wife of the Applicant were suffering from illness in the year 2016 and 2017. There is nothing on record to show the sufficient cause for not approaching this Tribunal in time challenging the impugned orders. It shows that the Applicant has made intentional and deliberate delay in filing the Original Application. Therefore, in my view, there is no just reason to condone the delay. However, considering the valuable rights of the Applicant involved in the Original Application and in the interest of justice, it is just to condone the delay by imposing the costs on the Applicant.

7. In view of above, in the interest of justice, the Misc. Application deserves to be allowed subject to payment of costs of Rs.5000/- by the Applicant.
