2. On perusal of the record it reveals that the issue involved in the present O.As. is dealt with and decided by this Tribunal Bench at Nagpur in O.A. No. 49/2005 in case of Mushtaque Ahmed Shaikh Dalulat Vs. The State of Maharashtra and Ors., decided on 16.09.2014 and it has been held that the Pharmacists are entitled to get the pay scale of Rs. 5500-9000. The said decision has been challenged by the Government before the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Bench at Nagpur in W.P. No. 7116/2017 and the Hon'ble High Court has dismissed it on 23.07.2018. Since the issue involved in present O.As. has already been decided by this Tribunal and the Hon'ble High Court, the said decision is binding on the respondents. But in spite of it, the respondents have not taken decision in the present matter.

3. In view thereof, it is just and proper to direct the respondents to state on oath as to whether the judgment of this Tribunal Bench at Nagpur in O.A. No. 49/2005 in case of Mushtaque Ahmed Shaikh Dalulat Vs. The State of Maharashtra and Ors., decided on 16.09.2014, as well as, the decision of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No. 7116/2017 decided on 23.07.2018 are binding on them. If the respondents are of the view that the said judgments are binding on them, then they have to take the corrective steps. If they are of the view that the said decision cannot be relied upon and not applicable to the present case, then they have to file affidavit stating the reasons in that regard.
