The Applicant is suspended by order dated 04.04.2015 in view of the registration of offence vide Crime No.19/2015 u/s 7, 13(1) (d) r/w 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. He was acquitted in Special Case No.05/2016 by the judgment dated 30.09.2016. The D.E. was also initiated against him and the report was submitted to Disciplinary Authority on 12.05.2017.</p> <p>3. Despite the submission of enquiry report, no further action was taken for passing final order in D.E. and therefore, Applicant has approached this Tribunal.</p> <p>4. The Tribunal by order dated 04.09.2019 directed the learned C.P.O. to file Affidavit to explain the status of file of D.E. and also to explain the delay in passing the final order.</p> <p>5. Today, in terms of order passed by this Tribunal, learned C.P.O. has filed short Affidavit of Shri Rajesh Ghadge, Joint Secretary (Admn.), Law &amp; Judiciary Dept, Mumbai. Learned C.P.O. stated that because of work load, final order could not be passed in D.E. by the then Principal Secretary. She further submits that now hearing is scheduled on 27.09.2019 before the Principal Secretary and Remembrancer of legal Affairs-cum-Disciplinary Authority and after hearing, necessary orders will be passed.</p> |

6. Whereas, learned Counsel for the Applicant has raised serious grievance for four years delay in revoking the suspension of the Applicant and prayed that he be reinstated in service.

7. True, there is considerable delay in taking decision in D.E. which could have been avoided. However, now hearing is already scheduled on 27.09.2019 and on hearing necessary orders will be passed so that the decision about reinstatement of the Applicant can be taken subject to outcome of D.E.

8. In view of above, Original Application is disposed of with directions to pass final order in D.E. within a month from the date of hearing which is scheduled on 27.09.2019. The decision as the case may be, shall be communicated to the Applicant within two weeks thereafter and necessary orders be passed subject to outcome of D.E.

9. Original Application is disposed of with no order as to costs.


