- (a) Shri (Dr.) Anup Kumar Yadav, Director of Health Services, Mumbai is called to show cause as to why he should not be saddled with additional costs of Rs. 25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand only) towards his reckless, rustic and rude attitude of consciously neglecting to show cause.
- (b) Shri M.P. Gude, learned Presenting Officer is called to show cause as to why he should not be saddled with costs for failing in his duty to appraise and caution Shri (Dr.) Anup Kumar Yadav, I.A.S., Director of Health Services, Mumbai towards his rude, crude and uncultured attitude in drafting the affidavit without incorporating reply to show cause at his own end, and without consulting learned C.P.O. or P.O.
