All the Applicants stand retired on 31.05.2017. Before retirement, the charge sheet was served upon them on 17.02.2017 for some irregularities and alleged misconduct of causing loss to the Government. The Applicants have already submitted their reply to the charge sheet but thereafter no further effective step is taken and the D.E. is simply pending without any progress. It appears that initially Enquiry Officer was appointed on 08.03.2019. Suffice to say, there is inordinate and undue delay in completion of D.E.</p>

4. Indeed, in terms of Circular dated 07.04.2008 issued by G.A.D. directions were issued to complete the D.E. within six months and where D.E. is not completed within six months, the concerned authority is required to seek extension for the same.

5. However, in the present case though the period of near about two years six months is over, D.E. is still pending without any substantial progress. As result of which gratuity and regular pension of the Applicants are withheld.

6. In view of above, Original Application deserves to be disposed of with suitable directions so that Applicants could get their legitimate dues subject to final order in D.E.

7. In view of above, Original Application is disposed of with direction to Respondent Nos.1 and 2 to ensure completion of D.E. within four months from today and final order thereon shall be passed within a month thereafter and the same shall be communicated to the Applicants.

8. On completion of D.E., retiral benefits of the Applicants be released forthwith subject to outcome of D.E.

9. No order as to costs.


