2. The present Miscellaneous Application has been filed in O.A. St. No. 150/2019, which is registered as O.A. No. 115/2019 seeking following reliefs: -

“A. This Misc. Application may kindly be allowed.

B. The impugned promotion orders issued by the respondent no. 4 vide order / letter dated 15/02/2019 may kindly be stayed till the final disposal of the Original Application No. 150/2019 and for that purpose necessary direction be issued.”

3. The Original Application St. No. 150/2019 was registered as O.A. No. 115/2019. In the said O.A. the following interim order was passed while issuing notices on 6.2.2019 : -

“8. Upon hearing both the sides, it appears that the applicant is placed at ZERO level as he was transferred from one circle to another circle. Learned Advocate for the applicant however, relies on the ratio of the decision rendered by the Nagpur Bench of this

Tribunal in O.A. No. 545/2015 [Nitin Tulshiram Gadpayale Vs. State of Maharashtra & Ors.], a copy of which is filed today on record at Annexure "X". Paragraph No. 20 of the said judgment would show that the issue is already decided by the Principal Seat at Mumbai of this Tribunal.

9. In the circumstances, without filing any detailed affidavit in reply the concerned respondents are directed to go through the said judgment and take corrective steps, if any and file report about the same on the next date. In case, for any valid reason the concerned respondents come to the conclusion that no corrective steps can be taken then a short affidavit explaining the reasons therefor be filed on record by the next date.

4. Learned Chief Presenting Officer has submitted a copy of interim order dated 13/11/2018 in which the Hon'ble High Court Bench at Nagpur has stayed the order of Nagpur Bench of this Tribunal dated 5th November, 2018 regarding 'ZERO' seniority for the Forest Guards transferred from one Circle to another Circle. In the judgment of Nagpur Bench of this Tribunal delivered in the case of **Nitin Tulshiram Gadapayale & Ors. Vs. the State of Maharashtra & Ors. (O.A. No. 545/2015 & Group) on 5th November, 2018**, reliance was made in paragraph 20 of the order dated 22.12.2015 passed in **O.A. No. 571/2015 (Sanjiv Tryambak Shinde Vs. State of Maharashtra and Others)** decided by Principal Bench of this Tribunal. The copy of the said order is taken

on record and marked as document 'X' for the purposes of identification. If the order of Nagpur Bench of this Tribunal was stayed by Hon'ble High Court, the order dated 06.02.2019 passed in O.A. No. 150/2019 become infructuous.

5. It is quite shocking that Advocate for the Applicant while relying on the order of Nagpur Bench has misled this Bench by not giving details of the developments occurred after the pronouncement of the order by Nagpur Bench of this Tribunal i.e. the stay granted by the Hon'ble High Court on 13.11.2018.

6. In view of above, no interim relief can be granted and the present M.A. stands disposed of without any order as to costs.

7. Learned Chief Presenting Officer submits that necessary corrections are being carried out in paragraph Nos. 4 to 7 of the order dated 15.2.2019.

8. The O.A. No. 115/2019 be placed on 25.03.2019.
