2. The applicant has filed application for condonation of 1 year 4 months and 19 days' delay for filing the O.A. It is contention of the applicant that because of the heavy work load he could able to approach this Tribunal. It is his contention that the delay caused for filing the O.A. is not intentional or deliberate.

3. learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the applicant has given sufficient explanation for condonation of delay caused for filing the O.A. He has further submitted that the valuable rights of the applicant are involved in the O.A. Therefore, he has

prayed to allow the M.A. by condoning the delay caused for filing the O.A.

4. Learned P.O. states that there is no just ground to condone the delay caused for filing the O.A. Delay is intentional and deliberate and such an inordinate delay cannot be condoned as the applicant has not explained the delay satisfactorily. Therefore, the learned P.O. has prayed to reject the M.A.

5. On perusal of the contentions raised by the applicant in the M.A., it reveals that the applicant has not mentioned sufficient and just cause for condonation of delay. Delay of 1 year 4 months and 19 days occurred for filing the O.A. In the absence of sufficient reasons, delay cannot be condoned. However, considering the fact that valuable rights of the applicant are involved, in my view, it is just and proper to condone the delay by imposing costs.

6. In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case, M.A. is allowed subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only). The applicant

shall deposit the costs with Registry of the Tribunal on or before 09-08-2019.

7. On depositing the costs, Registry shall register the O.A. as per rules and procedure after removal of office objections, if any.

8. On failure to deposit the costs within stipulated period by the applicant, M.A. stands dismissed automatically without any further order.
