





2. Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the M.A. No.43/2018 filed by the applicant issuing direction to the respondents has been dismissed in default as the applicant has failed to collect the notices in time. It is contention of the applicant that due to inadvertence, the clerk of the advocate could not able to collect the notice in time. Therefore, he prayed to restore the matter to its original number by setting aside the order of dismissal passed in M.A. No. 43/2018.
3. Learned C.P.O. for the respondents has strongly objected to restore the matter to its original number.
4. On going through the record, it reveals that in M.A. 43/2018 in O.A.1103/2017, the applicant has claimed direction to the respondents to grant ad-hoc promotion to the Applicant to the post of Executive Engineer (Mechanical) subject to the outcome of the O.A. No. 1103/2017.
5. This tribunal issued notice to the respondents in the M.A.43/2018 on 25.01.2018. The applicant could not collect the notice in time and, therefore, it came to be dismissed. The applicant has mentioned the reasons for not collecting the notices in time in para 3 in the application. The reasons tendered by the applicant seems to be just proper to allow the M.A. and to set aside the order of dismissal passed in M.A. No.43/2018. Therefore, in the interest of justice for the reasons mentioned in the application, the M.A. is allowed and order of dismissal passed in M.A. No. 43/2018 is set aside and M.A. No. 43/2018 be restored to its original number. On restoration of M.A.No. 43/2018 fresh notices to the respondents be issued.
