ORDER

1. Heard Shri A. V. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Smt. Kranti Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. Learned Counsel for the Applicant seeks interim relief on two grounds. (i) Non-service of transfer order and (ii) Non-observance of provisions of Section 22J-3 of Maharashtra Police Act which inter-alia provides for establishment of PEB at the level of specialized agency.
3. Applicant was posted as DYSP by order dated 04.08.2019. However, he is transferred mid-term and mid-tenure by order dated 09.01.2020 and was relieved by order dated 18.01.2020.
4. Insofar as the ground of non-service transfer order dated 09.01.2020 is concerned, learned P.O. fairly concedes that order is not served upon the Applicant but sought to contend that there is reference of transfer order in relieving order. Indeed, the transfer order ought to have been served upon the Applicant. Learned P.O., therefore, directed to ensure that transfer order dated 09.01.2020 is served immediately upon the applicant.

5. By transfer order dated 09.01.2020, the Applicant has been transferred from ACB, Pune to SID, Mumbai.
6. True, as per Section 22J-3 r/w 22J-4 in case of transfer out of specialized agencies, the concerned PEB at specialized agency is required to recommend the transfer to PEB No.2. PEB No.2 is at the level of Director General & Inspector General of Police is defined in Section 22E and its functions are defined in Section 22F of Maharashtra Police Act.
7. In present case, the Applicant has been transferred out of specialized agency namely ACB.
8. True, there is no recommendation of PEB at the level of specialized agency i.e. at the level of Anti Corruption Bureau as seen from file produced by the learned P.O. However, there is approval to transfer by PEB No.2 at the level of Director General of Police. The transfer seems to have made in view of serious allegations of misconduct of the Applicant while functioning in ACB.
9. Insofar as the post held by the Applicant is concerned, though he was posted as DYSP, indeed, he is in the rank of PI and by virtue of his transfer in ACB, he was step up in the pay-scale of DYSP in ACB.
10. In view of above, I am not inclined to grant interim relief as no prima-facie case is made out to stay the impugned transfer order.
11. Issue notice before admission returnable on 04.02.2020.
12. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
13. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

14. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

15. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

16. In case notice is not collected within three days or service report on affidavit is not filed 3 days before returnable date, Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.
