ORDER

1. Heard Shri Prashant Suryawanshi, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Ms. S.P. Manchekar, the learned Chief Presenting Officer with Shri A.J. Chougule, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. This Original Application was heard for sometime.
3. It had transpired that the action of Respondents issuing corrigendum and abolishing the women reservation in Class IV, sweeper category is unjust.
4. Respondent No.2, Commandant, S.R.P.F. Group, Kolhapur was called to take decision as to whether he would take corrective steps.
5. Learned C.P.O. Ms. S.P. Manchekar appeared for Respondent No.1 and has expressed that it is difficult for the Respondent No.2 to take suo motu corrective action.
6. It has transpired that the reasons due to which the reservation for women was cancelled is based on the misconception that since the reservation of seats has not been made applicable to Class IV, sweeper category, even the reservation for women is not permitted.

7. Applicant has averred that reservation for women is already observed in other units of S.R.P.F., and this plea is not denied by the Respondent No.2.
8. In fact standing directions of the State Government do not tend to prohibit the reservation reckoning candidates belonging to reservation categories in Class IV category for computation purpose.
9. Respondent No.1 who has committed grave illegality and took action contrary to the policy of the State of granting 30% reservation for women has surprisingly refused to review and correct his own action. Reasons of inhibition are strange. Refusal to undo injustice amounts to aggravating injustice to a larger magnitude.
10. In this situation we are left with no other choice then to call the Director General of Police to look into the matter personally.
11. It is seen that in this case the Director General of Police is not the party, however, considering the grave lapse committed by the Commandant, S.R.P.F. Kolhapur, who seems to be unwilling to correct his action, it is necessary to call upon the Director General of Police that he should call for the papers, study those papers himself and file affidavit-in-reply stating as to whether he subscribes to the action impugned, and even abstinence of the Respondent No.2 from taking corrective measures.
12. Affidavit of the Director General of Police be filed on or before next date.
13. In the event corrective measures are taken and those are reported before next date, it shall not be necessary for the Director General of Police to file affidavit-in-reply.
14. Steno copy and Hamdast is allowed to learned C.P.O..
15. Learned C.P.O. is directed to communicate this order to the Respondents.






