Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the written examination has been conducted by the respondent No. 2 i.e. the Sub Divisional Officer, Parola, Tq. Parola, Dist. Jalgaon and thereafter, result has been declared. Now the respondent is intending to schedule oral interview and documents verification. He has submitted that, as the notification has not given wide publicity, aspiring candidates have no opportunity to file applications and to participate in the recruitment process. Therefore, he has prayed to stay the recruitment process.

3. Learned Presenting Officer has submitted that the notification has been published as per the recruitment rules and wide publicity has been given to it as provided under rules and there is no illegality in it. He has submitted that already aspiring candidates have filed applications and appeared for written examination. The result of written examination has been declared and now, the competent authority is going to conduct interviews of the eligible candidates. He has submitted that it would not be proper to grant stay to the recruitment process at this stage and therefore, he prayed to reject the M.A.

4. On going through the record, it reveals that in response to the notification published by the respondent No. 2, the aspiring candidates filed their applications and participated in recruitment process. Thereafter, they appeared for written examination and the result of the written examination has been declared by the respondent No. 2 i.e. the S.D.O., Parola, Dist. Jalgaon recently and he is going to take oral interview in near future in view of the recruitment rules. Considering this, it would not be proper to grant stay to the recruitment process at this advanced stage of recruitment process. Therefore, in my view, it is not a fit case to grant stay to the recruitment process. Hence, the M.A. deserves to be rejected.

5. In view of this, the M.A. is rejected with no order as to costs.
