2. In the present O.A. the challenged is to the transfer order dated 20.02.2019 whereby the applicant has been transferred to Ahmadnagar. However ~~Subsequently~~ ~~significantly~~ the earlier Order has been modified and the applicant is now transferred to Malegaon.

3. As such the impugned order being modified by the Department and the Applicant is transferred to Malegaon district Nashik, he does not want to continue the Application.

4. In view of above he has also tendered the application to that effect.

5. in view above Original Application is allowed.

6. O.A. accordingly disposed of, with no order as to costs.
