Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that he tried to collect the copy of the petition filed before the Hon'ble Apex Court challenging the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay in W.P. No. 10471 of 2014 in case of Shri Vikar Ansar Shaikh and Ors. Vs. the State of Maharashtra and Ors. decided on 13.11.2017, but he could not be able to produce the same. He has submitted that deceased Shri Uddhav Rajaramji Raut was working as Muster Assistant and he died on 16.10.1998. He has submitted that the Government has absorbed the Muster Assistants, but before absorption deceased Shri Uddhav Rajaramji Raut died. Though he died before absorption, he is entitled to get benefit of scheme of absorption which confers Muster Assistant the status as Government servant. Therefore, the legal heirs of the deceased employee Shri Uddhav Rajaramji Raut are entitled to claim benefit of the scheme for appointment on compassionate ground. He has submitted that the

respondents had wrongly rejected the application of the applicant on the basis of the decision given by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay in W.P. No. 10471 of 2014 in case of Shri Vikar Ansar Shaikh and Ors. Vs. the State of Maharashtra and Ors. decided on 13.11.2017.

3. Learned Presenting Officer has submitted that deceased Shri Uddhav Rajaramji Raut was not absorbed in the Government service in view of the scheme introduced by the Government. Since Shri Uddhav Rajaramji Raut died before absorption, he is entitled to claim benefits of absorption. The respondents have rightly rejected the application of the applicant on the basis of the decision rendered by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay in W.P. No. 10471 of 2014 in case of Shri Vikar Ansar Shaikh and Ors. Vs. the State of Maharashtra and Ors. decided on 13.11.2017.

4. On perusal of the record, it reveals that the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay in W.P. No. 10471 of 2014 in case of Shri Vikar Ansar Shaikh and Ors. Vs. the State of Maharashtra and Ors. decided on 13.11.2017, considered the G.Rs. dated 01.12.1995 and 21.04.1999, issued by the Government and observed as follows :-

"9. We have perused the entire gamut of the matter and the undisputed facts involved. It is not in dispute that the State Government resolved to absorb the Muster Assistants into

Government service and formulated a scheme for absorption of such Muster Assistants who were in service on 31st May, 1993 by issuing Government resolution on 1st December, 1995. By the said Government Resolution the State Government framed a Scheme for absorption of such Muster Assistants and also constituted a Divisional Level Committees for effectively implementing the decision of the State Government. Perusal of the said Government Resolution reveals that it contained clause 5.2 which reads as follows :-

“The Muster Assistants will not be entitled for any benefits or facilities applicable to a Government servant except the pay scale which they are presently drawing and they will not be recognized as Government employees.”

Further the Government Resolution dated 21st April, 1999 in clause no.5 provides as follows :-

“The Muster Assistants working under the EGS Scheme are not Government Employees and therefore the Maharashtra Service Rules as well as the Rules applicable to the State Government employees are not applicable to them. Therefore, the benefits of 5th Pay Commission will not be made applicable to them.”

The Hon'ble High Court has further held that the Muster Assistants are not entitled to get benefits available to the Government employees, when they are working as Muster Assistants.

5. In the present case, deceased Shri Uddhav Rajaramji Raut had not been absorbed in the

Government service and before absorption he died while working as Muster Assistant. In view of the above said G.Rs. and decision rendered by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay in W.P. No. 10471 of 2014 in case of Shri Vikar Ansar Shaikh and Ors. Vs. the State of Maharashtra and Ors. decided on 13.11.2017, deceased Shri Uddhav Rajaramji Raut cannot be treated as Government servant. Therefore, the scheme granting benefits to the legal heirs of the deceased Government employee for appointment on compassionate ground is not applicable to the present applicant. The respondents have rightly rejected the application of the applicant. I find no illegality in the impugned order. There is no merit in the O.A. Hence, the O.A. deserves to be dismissed.

6. In view thereof, the O.A. stands dismissed with no order as to costs.
