- (i) The Chamber Appeal No. 17/2019 is allowed as the applicant undertakes to remove the office objections within a reasonable period.
- (ii) Registrar of this Tribunal Bench at Aurangabad is directed to register the O.A. after removing the office objections by the learned Advocate for the applicant and place it before the appropriate Bench for hearing.

It appears from the record that by order dtd. 13.3.2019 passed in O.A. st. no.558/2019 by way of ad interim relief it was directed that final select list shall not be prepared unless specific permission is sought from this Tribunal. In the O.A. the applicants are contesting the method of recruitment as mentioned in sub clauses 1 to 5 of clause 12 of the advertisement dtd. 30.1.2019 (page 27) and regarding the certain questions asked in the examination as referred at page nos. 40 to 44.

4. In view of above, the respondents in O.A. are directed to prepare the merit list and it should be filed before this Tribunal by 19th August, 2019 in a sealed cover clearly showing the distinct benchmarks for degree and diploma holders.

5. S.O. to 22.8.2019 for above compliance from the side of respondent State and also for suitable modification of interim relief, if any, in the interim relief granted already in favour of the applicants in O.A.
