2. In the present matter, the challenge is to the transfer order dated 31.05.2017 whereby the Applicant, who is working as Driver at Nashik was transferred to Kalvan.

3. At the very outset, Shri Khaire, learned Advocate pointed out that there is no compliance of directions issued by this Tribunal in O.A.513/2018 on 21.12.2018 to take review of suspension of the Applicant within two months from the date of order. 
