2. The applicant has filed the present Original Application with a prayer to direct the respondent Nos. 1 & 2 to initiate Departmental Enquiry against the respondent Nos. 3 to 6.

3. Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the applicant initially approached the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad by filing W.P. No. 3049/2019. It was disposed of on 04.03.2019 and he was permitted to withdraw the said W.P. with liberty to avail alternate remedy. He has submitted that the respondent Nos. 3 to 6 are in the Government service and the applicant has grievance against them. Therefore, the applicant has approached this Tribunal by filing the present O.A. He has submitted that this Tribunal is competent to take cognizance of the application, as it is against the Government servants.

4. Learned Presenting Officer has submitted that the applicant is not the Government servant and he is

an agriculture. Therefore, he has no *locus standi* to file the present Original Application. He has submitted that the present Original Application is in the nature of public interest litigation. This Tribunal has no jurisdiction to take cognizance of such litigation. Therefore, he prayed to reject it.

5. On perusal of the record, it reveals that the present applicant, who is an agriculturist, has filed the present O.A. against the respondent Nos. 3 to 6, who are the Government employees. The applicant has no *locus standi* to file the present O.A. Moreover, the applicant is not aggrieved by any order. Therefore, the present O.A. is not maintainable in view of the provisions of Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act 1985. The O.A. seems to be in the nature of public interest litigation. Therefore, this Tribunal is not competent to entertain the application. On that count also the O.A. is not maintainable. Hence, it requires to be rejected.

6. In view of this, the O.A. stands rejected with no order as to costs.
