Further house of his father

is also acquired for the said project. It however, does not clarify as to whether the acquired land is 75% or more of the land held by the applicant's father. Further it is silent as to whether the house is acquired as it was being submerged in the project. For this reason, the concerned respondents are refusing to give the benefit as claimed by the applicant.

5. Since certificate is vague the applicant could have supplied other supplementary documents like certified copy of account (Khat-Utara) of his father viz. Hanamanata Bandu Mhaske which would have showed as to how much land was held by his father. Further documents that the house was acquired for submerging could have been collected by the applicant from the concerned competent authority. The applicant should not suffer for the vagueness in the said certificate.

6. In the circumstances, one fair opportunity is granted to the applicant to file additional documents to elaborate the said issue, upon which an appropriate decision can be rendered.

**ORAL ORDER :**

2. By filing the present O.A., the applicant is claiming following reliefs :-

*“(B) By way of issuing direction to Respondent no. 2 to decide the proposal dated 15.9.2016 submitted by the Respondent no. 3 for condoning the technical breaks given prior to selection by M.P.S.C. & should have given her benefits of Continuity in service from the date of initial appointment of the applicant as the similarly situated employees have got the consequential benefits by condoning the technical break in view of the Circular dated 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 issued by the Government of Maharashtra (Law & Judiciary Department) in the interest of justice.*

*(C) The Respondents may kindly be directed to extend the benefits of annual increments to the applicant of the service prior to selection by M.P.S.C. on the post of Medical Officer by condoning the technical breaks in the interest of justice.*

*(D) The Respondents may kindly be directed to revise the pay fixation of the applicant by granting the benefits of annual increments as per the rules from the date of her initial joining on the post of Medical Officer.*

*(E) The Respondents may kindly be directed to consider her seniority from the date of joining i.e. 4.8.1997 on the post of Medical Officer & give all consequential benefit of service seniority and promotion on higher post which is applicable to applicant in the interest of justice.”*

3. Essentially upon the decision of the proposal dtd. 15.9.2016 (Annex. A. 3 page 21) all the reliefs will have to be considered by the respondents.

4. In the circumstances, the present O.A. is disposed of without any order as to costs with a direction to the res. no. 2 – the Director of Health Services, Mumbai – to decide the proposal as mentioned above proposal dtd. 15.9.2016 (Annex. A. 3 page 21) within a period of four months from the date of this order and communicate the order thereof to the present applicant in writing.
