Per contra Ld. PO has pointed out that as per GR dated 27.9.2017 if the medical officer present on spot found the candidate medically fit then his request for change of date cannot be allowed and the decision in this behalf would be by the MPSC. She has further pointed out that MPSC by letter dated 24.1.2020 has conveyed her that the applicant was found physically fit by the medical officer present on</p>

the spot but applicant himself did not participate in the further medical test and abstained from physical test.

6. She has also produced medical certificate of few candidates who were declared unfit by the medical officer and therefore only their request for change of date of physical test was accepted.

7. True, applicant has submitted medical certificate dated 4.11.2019 issued by Dr. Sampat Pungliya showing that he is suffering from Acute Lumbago but it is significant to know that except this medical certificate there is no other medical record of history of the said ailment/injury.

8. Indeed in terms of GR dated 27.9.2017 it is for the medical officer present on the spot to certify whether the candidate is fit to undergo physical test and if the medical officer is satisfied that the candidate is not fit to undergo physical test then only his request is to be considered by MPSC.

9. Whereas in present case the medical officer who was present on the spot has examined the applicant and certified that he is physically fit to undergo physical test. However, despite this certificate issued by medical officer on the spot and applicant seems to have abstained from participating in physical test. As such in terms of GR dated 27.9.2017 the decision of MPSC refusing request of the applicant for change of date of physical examination cannot be faulted with.

10. In view of the above, we are not inclined to grant interim relief as prayed for.




