

1. Heard Mr. S.S. Dere, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Mrs. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. The Applicant has challenged the transfer order dated 20.08.2021 *inter-alia* contending that he is transferred mid-term and mid-tenure in contravention of provisions contained in Section 4(5) of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as 'Transfer Act 2005' for brevity), and therefore, claimed interim relief.
3. Mr. S.S. Dere, learned Advocate for the Applicant sought to contend that Applicant had completed hardly two years and two months at Village Tarale as against normal tenure of six years but transferred abruptly on the basis of alleged complaints. According to him, unless

there is full pledged enquiry with opportunity of hearing, a Government servant cannot be transferred as provided in Circular dated 11.02.2015.

4. Whereas, Mrs. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer has pointed out that after compliance of legal formalities, having found *prima-facie* substance in the complaints, the Applicant has been transferred by the Collector, who is competent authority for mid-term and mid-tenure transfer of Talathi. The matter was placed before Civil Services Board and after approval of Collector, the Applicant is transferred from Tarale to Jinti.
5. True, the Applicant has not completed six years' normal tenure. However, the perusal of record *prima-facie* reveals that there are several complaints about the functioning and discharge of public duties by the Applicant. The Gram Panchayat had also passed Resolution on 15.03.2021 for transfer of the Applicant. The S.D.O. had also issued notice dated 20.01.2021 to the Applicant, but he did not reply. There are four charges against the Applicant out of which Charge No.3 in respect of complaint of Renuka Jadhav which seems to have been settled between the parties.
6. As such, *prima-facie*, there is compliance of Section 4(5) of 'Transfer Act 2005'.
7. It appears that earlier also while Applicant was serving at Nanegaon, there were complaints against her and she was transferred mid-term and mid-tenure by order dated 25.09.2018. The Applicant has challenged it by filing O.A.No.908/2018. That O.A. was allowed on merit since it was not placed before CSB and there was no opportunity of hearing to the Applicant on the complaint. ; The Applicant was accordingly reinstated, and thereafter, in general transfer, she was transferred to Village Tarale. Now at Tarale also, there were complaints against her which led to the passing of impugned order of transfer from Tarale to Jinti.

8. In view of above, interim relief to stay transfer order dated 20.08.2021 is rejected.
9. Issue notice to the Respondents returnable on 24th September, 2021.
10. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
11. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
12. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988 and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
13. The service may be done by Hand Delivery / Speed Post / Courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.


