The Applicant has, therefore, filed the present O.A. for direction that he should not be terminated by appointing another candidate in his place or he should continue till availability of regular candidate by M.P.S.C.</p> <p>3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that in similar situation M.A.T. Aurangabad Bench in O.A.No.587/2005 has granted interim relief (Order is at page nos.39 and 40 of PB). He, therefore prayed for interim relief to protect services of the Applicant.</p> <p>4. Per contra, learned P.O. submitted that there are complaints against the Applicant about conduct and performance, and therefore, Applicant is not entitled for continuation. She, therefore, opposes to grant of interim relief in favour of the Applicant.</p> <p>5. Heard Shri C.T. Chandratre, learned Advocate with Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocates for the Applicants, Ms. S.P. Manchekar, learned C.P.O. for Respondents No.1 to 3 and Shri S.S. Dere, learned Advocate for Respondents No.4 to 70.

2. Ld. Advocate for the applicants has amended prayer clause 9(a) at page 16 of OA. As per prayer clause 9(c), condition no.13 is mentioned in notification dated 2.7.2013 issued by Additional Director General of Police, Training and Special Cell, Mumbai (Exh.A-7 pg.41-46 of OA).

3. As per pleadings the order of this Tribunal against Government of Maharashtra's order dated 29.6.2013 (Exh.A-4 page 32) was stayed by the Hon'ble High Court and the same was upheld in the Hon'ble Supreme Court. So as of today the Government of Maharashtra's order dated 29.6.2013 (Exh.A-4 page 32) has attained finality.

4. A specific question was put to Ld. CPO that clause 13 mentioned above has been taken from which circular, resolution or recruitment rules. Ld. CPO is unable to produce any such document. Ld. CPO is directed to take instructions from the respondents and produce relevant record which has legal force to clause 13 of notification dated 2.7.2013 issued by Additional Director General of Police, Training and Special Cell, Mumbai (Exh.A-7 pg.41-46 of OA).

5. Ld. Advocate for the applicants has pointed out that Hon'ble Chairman has passed order on 11.4.2019 in which directions have been given to DGP to reply. To that Ld. CPO has filed reply at page 328-358. However, along with that reply no merit list is attached of the examination conducted on 30.8.2013. Ld. CPO is directed to produce compliance to the order dated 11.4.2019 of the Hon'ble Chairman.

6. Later on Ld. CPO submitted that list is ready with her. In view of this she was directed to supply the list to the Ld. Advocate for applicants and Ld. Advocate for private respondents no.4 to 70 for their verification.

7. Ld. Advocate for respondents no.4 to 70 pointed out clause 14 at page 37 and clause 22 at page 38 of OA. These two clauses will also be examined while deciding the OA.
