



That aspect of the matter will have to be studied in the context of the fact that whatever be the quantum, the delay is not so exorbitant as to reflect a State which could be called contumacious and negligent sleeping over the right. At the end of the day, the harp has to be on serving the cause of justice rather than sacrificing a good cause on the altar of procedure. Now, some negligence has to be there without which the delay would not be caused but the delay itself cannot be cited as a cause for not condoning it. When the issue is as to whether a case for condonation is constituted. I hold that the delay herein needs to be condoned.

The MA is allowed. The delay is condoned. The Office and the Applicant are directed to process the OA in order to get it placed before the Bench for further progress in the matter. No order as to costs.
