

Prima facie the contents of aforesaid para are incorrect as there is no such order of the Tribunal that the applicant has given up his claim of Scheduled Tribe. Indeed the Tribunal by order dated 4.6.2012 passed in OA No.502 of 2012 granted ad interim relief in favour of the applicant and later on merits the OA was allowed by order dated 21.1.2013. Thus, prima facie the basis of the impugned order seems to be incorrect.</p> <p>4. Further more as rightly pointed out by Ld.
