

2. Learned Advocate Shri Anup Lahoti has tendered service report. Perused the same. Learned Advocate Shri Anup Lahoti was asked to file the service report in the office during the course of the day.
3. It reveals from the service report that envelope contained the notice of the Tribunal is delivered in the office of Respondents on 23.05.2016.
4. Learned P.O. Ms. N.G. Gohad for the Respondents states that instructions in the form of e-mail communication and para-wise remarks dated 16.06.2016 and hard copy of the same is received in the office of Presenting Officer on 17.06.2016.
5. Learned P.O. Ms. N.G. Gohad prays for time for filing reply.





6. Perusal of para-wise remarks reveals that the officer who has signed seems to be wrongly informed about law in as much that he has unmindfully raised an objection as to the jurisdiction of the Tribunal.
7. Text of para-wise reply reveals from paragraph 6, thereof that the he has rejected the Applicant's candidature without applying mind to the facts of the case and without looking into the document such as FIR, charge-sheeted, etc., barely on the fact that the applicant was arrayed as accused in the FIR.
8. Be it as it is. In the background that the office of Superintendent of Police, Ratnagiri was served with the notice on 23.05.2016, it was his duty to contact the learned P.O. well in time to draft the affidavit-in-reply with the guidance and help of learned P.O., instead of drafting para-wise remarks as per his whims, and barely delivering para-wise remarks to the office of learned P.O..
9. Considering that the approach seen from para-wise remarks is wholly improper, learned P.O. Ms. N.G. Gohad was directed to furnish the name of the person holding the post of Superintendent of Police, Ratnagiri.
10. Learned P.O. Ms. N.G. Gohad has collected the name and furnished the following name :-
Shri Pranaya Ashok, Superintendent of Police, Ratnagiri.
11. Shri Pranaya Ashok, Superintendent of Police, Ratnagiri is called to show case as to why he should not be personally saddled with costs for not being diligent and punctual in taking steps for filing affidavit before due date.
12. Shri Pranaya Ashok, Superintendent of Police, Ratnagiri is further directed to file affidavit answering each and every paragraph, point and averment contained in the O.A..
13. Shri Pranaya Ashok, Superintendent of Police, Ratnagiri should also state as to whether original case papers were called and the seriousness of the accusation against the applicant and his involvement in the commission of offence was examined by the Committee.

14. Learned P.O. is directed to communicate this order to the officer concerned. Learned P.O. Ms. N.G. Gohad prays for three weeks time for communication and for securing the reply.

15. Though three weeks time, four weeks time is granted so that further loss of time can be avoided.
