2. The applicant has filed the O.A. No. 720/2019 for following reliefs:-

"B) *To hold and declare the order dated 05.08.2019 and the order dated 06.08.2019 issued by the Collector, Jalgaon are valid, correct and in consonance with Government Resolution dated 15.05.2019.*

C) *To quash and set aside the letter dated 06.08.2019 issued by the respondent No.2 to the office of the respondent No. 1 rejecting the claim of the applicant for absorption/inter district transfer from Jalgaon district to Ahmednagar district.*

D) *To direct the respondent No. 2 to implement the order dated 05.08.2019 and 06.08.2019 in respect of the absorption/inter district transfer of the applicant from the post of Talathi from Jalgaon district to Ahmednagar district i.e. respondent No. 2 by giving him the suitable posting on the post of Talathi forthwith."*

3. Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the respondent No. 2 started the recruitment process for the post of Talathi in Ahmednagar district. The written examination of the candidates has been conducted on 27.07.2019, but the result of the said examination is not yet declared and therefore, he has prayed to grant interim relief in favour of the applicant and to direct the respondent No. 2 to allow the applicant to join on the post of Talathi in Ahmednagar district in pursuance of the orders dated 05.08.2019 and 06.08.2019. He has submitted that the applicant has already been relieved from Chalisgaon on 05.08.2019 and he has submitted his application with the Collector, Ahmednagar to permit him to join the posting in Ahmednagar district. He has submitted that the Collector, Ahmednagar has not permitted him to join the post and informed the Secretary, Revenue and Forest Department, Mumbai regarding transfer of the applicant and recruitment process for the post of Talathi in Ahmednagar district. He has submitted that on transfer of the applicant, he is in hanging position and therefore, he has prayed to grant interim relief.

4. Learned Chief Presenting Officer has submitted that the Collector, Ahmednagar informed the Secretary, Revenue and Forest Department, Mumbai by the communication dated 06.08.2019 (Annexure A-11 of the O.A.), that the post on which the applicant has to be appointed/transferred has to be filled in by

way of recruitment and the advertisement for recruitment of the said post has been issued. The said recruitment process is in process. The written examination has been conducted. Since the post on the which the applicant has been transferred has to be filled in by way of recruitment, no post is available to the applicant in Ahmednagar district and the said fact has been informed to the Secretary, Revenue and Forest Department, Mumbai, by the communication dated 06.08.2019. He has submitted that in case the applicant is permitted to join the post of Talathi in Ahmednagar district, then prejudice will be caused to the rights of the candidates who were appeared for the examination and therefore, he has prayed to reject the interim relief as prayed for by the applicant.

5. On perusal of the record, it reveals that the applicant has been relieved from the Jalgaon district on 05.08.2019. He approached the Collector, Ahmendnagar on 06.08.2019 with a request to allow him to join on the post of Talathi in Ahmednagar district. The Collector, Ahmednagar on 06.08.2019 informed the Secretary, Revenue and Forest Department, Mumbai that no post of Talathi is available for the applicant in Ahmednagar district, as the recruitment process of the said post has been commenced and the recruitment process is in progress. The written examination of the aspiring candidates had been conducted on 27.07.2019 and the result of the said examination is awaited.

Therefore, in these circumstances, in my view, it will not be just and proper to interfere in the recruitment process and hence, the interim relief as prayed for by the applicant cannot be granted. It is not a fit case to grant interim relief to the applicant and therefore, the interim relief as claimed by the applicant is hereby rejected.

6. Accordingly, the M.A. No. 414/2019 stands rejected. There shall be no order as to costs.

2. The husband of the applicant deceased Rupchand Dhondu Taide was serving as a Police Constable with the Railway Police Force, Nagpur. He was dismissed from the service on 04.04.1967 after conclusion of the Departmental Enquiry. No pension was granted to him. He died on 10.08.2003. The applicant is claiming family pension after death of her husband deceased Rupchand Dhondu Taide. Deceased Rupchand Dhondu Taide neither challenged the dismissal order, nor he claimed pensionary benefits since the year 1967 till his death. The cause of action to claim pensionary benefits arose to deceased Rupchand Dhondu Taide in the year 1967. After death of Rupchand Dhondu Taide in the year 2003, the cause of action for claiming alleged pension arose to the applicant but, the applicant has not filed the O.A. within prescribed period of limitation. There is an inordinate delay of more than 52 years in filing the O.A. The delay is inordinate and no justifiable cause and explanation has been shown by the applicant in

the present M.A. for condonation of delay. The inordinate delay cannot be condoned in the absence of sufficient cause and explanation. Therefore, the M.A. deserves to be rejected.

3. In view thereof, the M.A. stands rejected. Consequently, the O.A. stands rejected. There shall be no order as to costs.

2. Vide order dated 21.06.2019 the Registrar of this Tribunal was pleased to refuse the registration under Rule 5 (4) of Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedural) Rules, 1988. On 10.04.2019 the office has raised the following office objections:-

- 1) Tribunal's order dated 05.12.2018 is not filed with M.A.
- 2) Delay is not mentioned in prayer clause for restoration of O.A.
- 3) Date on page No. 2 of M.A. is wrong.

3. Vide office note dated 12.06.2019 Registrar of this Tribunal at Aurangabad Bench noted that nobody appeared for the applicant and office objections not removed.

4. The applicant has made prayer for condonation of delay of about 42 days caused in filing Chamber Appeal No. 18/2019.

5. The learned Advocate for the applicant appeared today and undertakes to remove the aforesaid office objections.

**CHAMBER APPEAL NO. 18/2019**

6. Technically, the Registrar was right in refusing the registration since nobody appeared for the applicant in view of the objections in spite of repeated chances. The fact that the O.A. is filed challenging transfer, and in order to give an opportunity to the applicant to prove his claim on merits, it will be in the interest of justice to allow the chamber appeal as the applicant shall not suffer for the negligence of his Advocate. Hence, the following order:

**ORDER**

Delay of about 42 days caused in filing Chamber Appeal stands condoned.

(ii) The Chamber Appeal No. 18/2019 is allowed as the applicant undertakes to remove the office objections within a reasonable period.

(iii) Registrar of this Tribunal Bench at Aurangabad is directed to register the O.A. after removing the office objections by the learned Advocate for the applicant and place it before the appropriate Bench for hearing.
