The Applicant has challenged the transfer order dated 15.07.2021 whereby he is transferred from Mundwa Police Station to Special Branch within Police Commissionerate, Pune City on the ground of default report.</p> <p>3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant sought interim stay <i>inter-alia</i> contending that the Applicant is transferred mid-tenure without there being any special case as contemplated under Section 22 (N)(2) of Maharashtra Police Act.</p> <p>4. Whereas, learned P.O. has tendered the copy of Minutes of PEB which discloses that PEB recommended for the transfer of the Applicant on the ground of default report in which it was stated that the Applicant had close relations and contacts with land mafia and other criminals which caused hindrance to the administration.</p> <p>5. Thus, <i>prima-facie</i> it is on the basis of default report, the PEB had recommended for mid-tenure transfer of the Applicant. Though, the Applicant has not completed his normal tenure of two years, the PEB recommended for his transfer on administrative ground namely his relations with land mafia and other criminals.</p> <p>6. As such, this ground can be construed and <i>prima-facie</i> qualifies for as administrative exigency and in public interest. Therefore, I am not inclined to grant interim relief.</p> <p>7. The submission advanced by learned Counsel for the Applicant that Respondents ought to have been given show cause notice to the Applicant before transferring him on default report is totally misconceived and against the provisions of Maharashtra Police Act which <i>inter-alia</i> empowers the PEB to transfer mid-tenure if administrative exigency or public interest demands.</p> <p>8. 


